Adoption Contract

This health guarantee and adoption contract is between Shellie Johnson Brown ("Seller") and _____ ("Buyer"). This agreement applies solely to the cat/kitten described below.

Breeder Guarantee

1. To the best of the "Sellers" knowledge the cat/kitten above is free from any health problems, congenital defects or hereditary deformities.
2. The cat/kitten is to be examined by a licensed veterinarian within 48 hours of adoption. Any life threatening health problems discovered must be documented in writing with contact information, and presented to the "Seller" upon return of the cat/kitten within the same 48 hour period.
3. The cat/kitten will be replaced with one of equal value, if no animal is available at that time, a cat/kitten will be provided when one is available. **NO CASH REFUNDS!**
4. Health problems such as parasites (ex. Ringworm), change in diet, litter training, allergies, and anxiety brought on by environmental change or introduction of new animals are not covered in the health guarantee.
5. We recommend that your cat/kitten be spay or neutered between the ages of Four and Eight months. Any health problems occurring from this action will not be covered by this contract. **NO** registration paperwork will be given until proof of Spay or Neuter has been provided by a veterinarian, and can be verified.

6. All kittens are wormed at four weeks and receive their first shot at eight weeks. We recommend that all cats be wormed every three months and will need a second shot four weeks after their first shot. Annual vaccinations are recommended and are not covered under this agreement. Records will be provided at date of purchase.
7. Declawing is not recommended and will not be covered under this agreement.

Purchaser Agrees To:

1. Purchaser accepts the responsibility for the cat/kitten and its welfare once it has left the premises. These include but are not limited to prompt medical care, proper indoor sanitary facilities, adequate food and water, and the understanding that this cat has been sold with the intent to be an indoor pet and will not be allowed to roam out doors. This cat is not to be sold, leased or given to research facilities or to any pet shop. If the animal is found to be neglected, the purchaser will surrender the cat/kitten unconditionally and without any monetary compensation.
2. "Buyer" understands that every effort has been made by the "Seller" to ensure the health of this cat/kitten. Health problems such as ear mites, fleas, ringworm, parasites, intestinal worms and other minor problems may exist undetected. These situations are common and curable and are not grounds to return the cat/kitten. The "Buyer" has inspected the cat/kitten thoroughly at the time of purchase and noticed no evidence of the items listed above or any other condition that has not been disclosed by the "Seller".
